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Funeral Pre-Planning Guide

If you are the type of person who likes to plan ahead or if you know you have a life-limiting illness, planning your own funeral may be the right thing for you. Death is often a difficult subject to discuss with your loved ones, but necessary. It is not only important to discuss with your family, your medical plan for before you die, but also to have a plan in place for your funeral or memorial service. It is important to talk with your family about your wishes to make sure they know what you want. Having a verbal conversation about your wishes when you are still able to make decisions will help planning go smoothly later.

The purpose of a funeral is to give meaning to a person's life. It's an opportunity for family and friends to gather and remember the deceased while offering support and comfort to one another. Planning a funeral can be an emotional process. Often times, loved ones are unaware of your wishes for a funeral or memorial service. To help alleviate some of the stress in planning a funeral, you may complete the attached forms for Celebratoin to keep on file. The information is confidential and will only be read by the pastor and office administrator. It will be kept in a sealed envelope until the time of your death. The information will only be used in the planning of your funeral or memorial service to insure your wishes are carried out.
